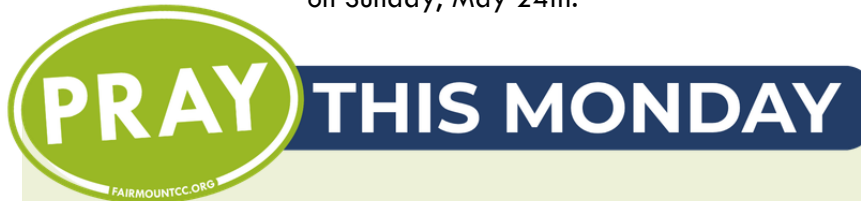


2026 PRC WALK FOR LIFE RESULTS
