Bibles for Papua New Guinea

Last month, Eric Taylor and Joe McHale embarked on an adventure to Papua New Guinea (PNG) to represent Fairmount at the Apal Bible Dedication in the remote village of Angguna in the Madang province of PNG. Fairmount donated the funds for the printing of the Bible, which was translated into the new language of the Apal people. Eric and Joe were both amazed by the level of devotion from the Apal people as well as the depth of the commitment of the full-time missionaries serving to spread God's Word in such a primitive region. The guys were thrilled to work with Martha Wade, one of those missionaries connected to Fairmount, who has spent over 40 years living among the Apal people. She has learned their language, developed it into a written language, and translated the Bible into that language—all while living in a remote jungle with no modern conveniences of any kind. Observing the people of Apal rejoicing over receiving God's Word provides a deeper appreciation for missionaries like Martha, for those involved in the important work of Bible translation, and for all of those who have a heart to pray for and support missions.


