Fairmount had many moments in 2023 that are worthy to be highlighted. In my mind, four moments stand out:

- **Habitat Faith Build**: Fairmount partnered with Habitat for Humanity to build a house for a family in Ashland. Fairmount's role included being a significant financial supporter of the project, providing lunches for work crews, and completing the landscaping around the house.
- **Fairmount's 120**th **birthday**: The Fairmount family gathered for one joint worship service on the last Sunday in August to celebrate 120 years. It was a time of worship that will be remembered and cherished for years to come. Included in our celebration was the ordination into ministry of Jacob Ward and the commissioning of our new church plant, Local Christian Church.
- **Local Christian Church is planted**: On it's 120th birthday, Fairmount gave birth to a new church. Local Christian Church held its first public worship services at Patrick Henry High School in Ashland on September 17. There were 120 people in attendance.
- **Scrooge the Musical**: As our Christmas gift to the community, Fairmount presented this adaptation of Charles Dickens classic, "A Christmas Carol". Held over the first two weekends in December, approximately 5,000 people attended.

Years ago, our staff was discussing Easter. Someone remarked that church experts regard Easter as the church's "Super Bowl Sunday". As a staff, we concluded that every Sunday at Fairmount is our "Super Bowl Sunday". We hold four worship services every Sunday morning that are dedicated to honoring God through music, prayer, communion, giving, and the preaching of God's Word.

As you will see, so many wonderful things took place at Fairmount in 2023. However, it all begins with our weekly Sunday morning worship. Thank you for being a part of the Fairmount family. Thank you for committing yourself to being here on Sunday mornings. Thank you for allowing God to use you to serve Him in amazing ways.

Enjoy this look back at 2023 and get ready for another year of serving God in 2024.


Our New Vision: Real Hope for Real People

Statistically, 2023, was a year full of blessings. Our staff conducted 33 funerals and 11 weddings. We had 62 additions to the church family - 34 baptisms and 28 transfers - not to mention several individuals from other church families who were baptized here at Fairmount. Fairmount's weekly worship attendance averaged 1,393. We averaged 533 men, women, and children per week in our discipleship ministries: Bible School, Bible Studies, and Life Groups. On top of all this excitement, we added two new staff members, Kasey Ogden and Lauren Haake. In addition, Chris Santasiere, Sherri Fadool, and Krista Barnes changed roles in their positions. God's hand has been in it all. And to Him we give all the glory!
