


### 2023 Christmas Campaign Announcement

God is always good. Praise and glory to God who has blessed our congregation with such generous people. Our 2023 Christmas campaign has ended, and you gave **\$357,271**! A tithe of \$35,727 will be split equally between IDES and Good News Productions to help those recovering from tragedies and to share Jesus around the world.

The remainder, \$321,544, will be applied to our loan for the construction of the worship center which opened in 2016. The worship center now has over 600 people each week worshipping Jesus, with many more gathering in the lobby every Sunday for fellowship. The worship center has hosted numerous concerts, conferences, and drama productions where Jesus has been shared, large funerals for the hurting where Jesus's love has been exhibited, and community gatherings where non-Christians have seen the cross in our lobby. The vision for the worship center was that more people could see Jesus, and that vision is being realized.

Thank you to the people who do not regularly worship there yet use the space and freely give so Jesus can be shared. Thank you to the people who have chosen to worship in this space and give. Thank you to the people who are here because of this space and give. Thank you to the people who pray for more people to fill this space.

All that we have comes from our Lord and Savior Jesus. Thank you for your gift, no matter the size, as you have shared what the Lord has blessed you with. We want to be good stewards with the Lord's blessings. We ask that you prayerfully consider giving on a regular basis to pay off the loan balance of just over \$1.8 million to allow the church to be debt-free by September 2026. 


#### Join us for Road to Resurrection on Sunday, March 24th
