
## **FORECASTER FAIRMOUNT CHRISTIAN CHURCH**



#### "Luci. You know... short for Lucifer" By Bob Weirup

Satan shows up at a church meeting - what could go wrong? That is the premise for the upcoming play "Luci." It's part comedy, part drama, part... well, that's all I'll say at this point. We're presenting six shows during the last weekend in October and the first weekend in November. As always, everyone is invited and there is no charge or ticket required to attend.

I wrote the first draft of this play some 14 years ago. At the time, Fairmount Drama was doing big musical plays every other year. We decided that we wanted to try to do some smaller plays between the big ones, but there were no funds budgeted for an off-year show. If I could write a play myself that didn't involve expensive play rights fees with a very simple set and no costume rentals, the result could produce a show that would be very cost-effective to bring to the stage. It took me about 6 months to write, and has only 3 cast members.

We presented the first iteration of the play at Fairmount in February 2015 under the title "A Most Beautiful Plan." The cast was Ray Butler, David Rice, and myself. We presented 4 shows. The play was well received, even though attendance was smaller than some of our larger shows.


This time around, we are re-inventing the show, with a mostly new cast. Jennifer McMillen (Luci) and Josh Norman (Ben) join David Rice (Sinatra) this time around, and we've renamed the show "Luci" (You know... short for Lucifer). David is back as Sinatra, because I wrote that part specifically for him. We did have to rearrange and alter some things, as Lucifer is now a female character instead of a male. This is a difficult play to perform, as Luci and Ben have 90% of the dialogue in this 90 minute play, and that means pages and pages of script memorization. They've been working hard and it shows, and I can't wait for you to see all three actors on stage - they're terrific.

And, as I said before, this is an inexpensive show to produce (which also means no advertising budget). It is also harder to draw people in with a show that is unfamiliar to them (as opposed to better known shows like Scrooge or Narnia). That's where we need your help - please spread the word about this show! Tell your family, tell neighbors, tell your co-workers, tell your friends.
