Why would Pilate have Jesus flogged before he had Him crucified?

In what ways can a “mob mentality” cause damage in the church?

In 1 Peter 3:8-17, how does Peter compare our suffering in Christ?

What do we learn from Jesus about dealing with pain and suffering?

Life Application – “What does it mean for me?”

Pray for the persecuted church in the world.

Beware of making false accusations or inaccurate statements of others.

Read all four Gospel accounts of Jesus' suffering, death, and resurrection.

Consider how God can use your influence in the lives of others to glorify Him.

Pray for all people in the world to recognize Jesus as the One and Only Son of the Living God.
