Read verses 7-8. For what reason did the people mock and hurl insults?

What requests did David make of God in verses 19-21?

What future events do we find predicted in verses 27-28? Read Revelation 7:9.

Observation: What Does It Mean?

Consider a time you have felt far from God. How did it change?

What does Psalm 22 teach us when we feel far from God?

How do we see the Holy Spirit show up in this psalm of David?

What are some practical action points that make verse 30 possible?

How does "fear of the Lord" and "praise of the Lord" go hand in hand?

Life Application: What Does It Mean For Me?

Read Romans 8:18-39 and highlight all of God's promises.

Make a list of the hard things in your life and pray for God to help you.

Make a praise list of all your many blessings and thank God for His faithfulness.
