

WEEK 2 | BAPTISM | ACTS 2:14-41

Inspection – "What does it say?"

What did the prophet Joel say in verse 17 that God would do in the last days? What promise did God make in verse 21? In what three ways did Jesus prove He was from God? (verse 22) What promise did God make to David in verse 30? What two commandments and one promise did Peter make in verse 38?

Observation – "What does it mean?"

According to verse 23, what is God's plan that was foreknown? What does it mean to be "cut to the heart" as seen in verse 37? According to verse 41, what must happen before baptism? Why is this necessary? What role does the Holy Spirit have in the life of the Christian? In what way can we "save ourselves" as seen in verse 40?

Life Application – "What does it mean for me?"

Consider how baptism into Christ has changed your life. Share your story with a friend. Pray daily for those in Israel who still deny Jesus as being God's Son. Memorize Acts 2:17-21. Make a list of some of Jesus' miracles, wonders, and signs. Read Romans 6.
