WEEK 14 | THE CROSS | MARK 16:1-20

Inspection – “What does it say?”

What did the women first notice when they came to the tomb? (verse 4)

What did the young man dressed in white instruct the women to do? (verse 7)

What do we learn about Mary Magdalene in verse 9?

In what condition were the disciples when Mary Magdalene found them? (verse 10)

What did Jesus do when He appeared to the eleven in verse 14?

Observation – “What does it mean?”

How does unbelief and fear impact Jesus’ followers today in the church?

How does the possible ending of verse 8 in the footnotes add weight to the remaining verses?

According to verse 16, what role does baptism play in our salvation?

Are the signs recorded in verses 17-18 for some or for all Christians?

Read verse 20. What role did the miraculous signs play in the preaching of the gospel?

Life Application – “What does it mean for me?”

Make a mental note of your past sin that has been forgiven and give thanks.

Identify any lack of faith and stubborn refusal you have harbored in your heart and repent.

Read Galatians 5:22-26 and practice daily the work of the Holy Spirit in your life.

Take to heart the words of Jesus to go and tell others about a risen Savior.

Host a resurrection party for Jesus and invite others to join the celebration.
